這種能力幫助人表達超出 自身環境的限制。

約翰被困在拔摩島,舉目 無助:但他看見的和表達 的卻是遠遠超過他所處的 有限時空。

今天我們好像被困,算是 不計經濟政治,就是人際 聯繫和生活範圍都大大縮 減了。許多人為此感到不 習慣,甚至喪氣埋怨。

不過我們還可以打電話· send e-mail 和 WhatsApp· 但在香港有一群人他們連 這些也沒有而活動範圍及 和外間的聯繫比我們少許 多,他們就是在囚人士。 他們的活動範圍及和外間 聯繫比我們最少的還要少



許多。但他們中有不少盡一切方法讓自己可以超越 團牆的限制一沒電話就用 書信,沒視像就用圖畫。 特別是後者,就是沒讀 書不識字也可以做到。許 多四友都是用自己畫的 或時來向家人(特別是年 幼子女)表達自己沒法用 文字來表達的感情和感受。

在信仰的表達也一樣:他 們未必能夠掌握和表達深 奧的神學觀念和辭彙,但 可用圖畫直接表達所感所 想的: 不需要很高的技 巧,只要有真摯的感情。

我們為囚友舉辦繪畫比賽 和展覽,一方是鼓勵他們 表達他們的信仰內心世界,另一方面是讓他們藉作品飛越圍牆和外間的人分享。又藉觀眾所寫的應,讓他們感受外間的關懷。何況他們知道自己的作品是和外國囚友作品一同展覽,這個飛越的感覺就更大了。

只要還有表達內心感受的 能力和機會,只要知到有 人願意「閱讀」這些表 達,他們就會看見生命的 光,更有耐心等候「新天 新地」了。



圍牆困不住思想的自由。

我從一班囚友及更生人士的藝術作品中,清楚看到他們 腦海中的天空宇宙。

《信心啟航—藝術作品展》作為一個媒介,讓人與人之間 再沒有任何形式的隔閡,囚友們以作品代替他們説話, 表達他們的情感。



在展場中,我看到一幅名為《Getting Free》的畫作,一只代表捆鎖的手銬,鐵鍊的末端是一群代表自由的鴿子,意像簡而深,令人動容。還有以渴慕神為主旨的畫作《God》,內容描述寫着「God is always with me」,一名女子跪坐在地上禱告,雖然看不到女子的面容,但肢體語言看出她的渴求與懇切,而耶穌就在她的禱告中,光照她,讓我直接感受到她雖然暫時失去人身自由,卻仍得到神的安慰,仍在困難中堅守信仰。



還有《The Sun Will Rise Again》,題目充滿盼望,內容卻描畫了一個滴着淚的男子跪在鐵籠內,看着白鴿叼着鑰匙飛走,看到作者當下的心情,讓人感同身受。

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During the pandemic period, we were not given permission to host evangelistic meetings by the CSD, praise God we were allowed to make videos of the Christmas celebration and sermon for watching inside prisons. Before Christmas, we had recorded bilingual Christmas sermons in DVD format so that inmates could watch the Christmas evangelistic celebration and sermon which were composed of singing Christmas songs, worship dancing, a testimony and sermon. We thank God and express appreciation to our volunteers for their support in the production of the videos and to CSD for their arrangement of showing our videos across most institutions. We will make more videos of religious classes in DVD format in the coming year. We invite churches to join in the production of the videos. Please pray that we may be given wisdom in how to deliver the gospel message and care for the inmates by means of video.

Thank God! 172 reply slips were received from different institutions after Christmas last year; the inmates felt very encouraged when they received the Christmas gift packages. Their responses show their willingness to follow our Lord Jesus, they want to participate in letter



writings, religious classes, and Bible correspondence courses. After seeing the response, the co-workers immediately made various follow-up arrangements, asking the Lord to protect the inmates' hearts and build them up.

The "Angel Tree Christmas Programme 2020" was affected by the Covid 19 pandemic, and so our volunteers were not able to visit and personally give gifts to the children of the inmates applied. Instead, we contacted the families of the inmates and delivered the gifts outdoors. Thank God for allowing the process of giving to go smoothly. A total of 335 gifts were sent to 96 local families and 132 parcels were sent overseas. May the children feel the love of their parents in custody after receiving their gifts.

Chairman's Message In the beginning, God created heavens and earth. The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the spirit of the Lord was hovering over the face of the waters. And God said: "Let there be light." There was light. And God saw that the light was good, And God separated the light from the darkness. God called the light "day" and the darkness "night". And there was evening and there was morning. The first day. Genesis 1:1-5

"And God said" was the means that God used to express and communicate. When God expresses his will, it becomes the way and the power of creation; when he reveals his love to others, the word became flesh, who "dwelled among us, full of grace and truth." Christ is the true image of God completely reflecting the characteristics of God; although people are lost due to sin, they have not lost the ability to create and express. Various arts such as literature, music, fine arts, and drama are derived from this ability.

This ability helps people express beyond the limits of their own environment.

"Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea. I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband." (Revelation 21:1-2)

When John was trapped on Patmos Island he looked helpless; but what



he saw far exceeded the limited time and space he was in.

Today we can feel trapped, regardless of economics and politics, that is, interpersonal connections and the scope of life have been greatly reduced. Many people have felt unaccustomed to this, even frustrated and complaining.

But we can still make phone calls, send e-mails or text messages, but there are a group of people in Hong Kong who don't even have these, and their scope of activities and contact with the outside world are much less than us. They are persons in custody. Their scope of activities and contacts with the outside world are much less than ours. But many of them will try to do what they can to go beyond the limitations of the wall by writing letters instead of mobile calling, and drawing pictures instead of video conferencing. Especially the latter, one can do that even if one hasn't read a book or cannot read. Many inmates use pictures or cards drawn by themselves to express to their family members (especially young children) their feelings that they cannot express in words.

The same applies to the expression of faith: they may not be able to master and express profound theological concepts and vocabulary, but they can express what they feel and think with



pictures; they do not need much skills, as long as they are sincere.

We hold painting competitions and exhibitions for inmates. On one hand, we want to encourage them to express their feelings and their inner world, and on the other hand we provide a platform to let them use their creativity to go beyond the walls and share with people outside. I also revert to the feedback written by the attendees to let the participants know that we care for them from outside too. They know that their works are being exhibited together with the works of other foreign inmates. This empowers them to feel more connected with others.

Once they know that someone is willing to "appreciate" their expressions through paintings, they will see the light of life and be more patient in waiting for the "new heaven and new earth."

"Hope Shines" — Appreciate the Heart

Wong Sze Kam (Senior Ministry Officer)

From my experience in the past, visiting and appreciating artworks piece by piece in art galleries was always very pleasing and enjoyable. However, never have I imagined that there would be this opportunity to organize and coordinate an art exhibition known as "Hope Shines" for KSA in 2020. 39 colorful paintings and 1 3-D artwork were exhibited. Thanks to an international organization of prison art, A Touch of Light, for their free offering of 20 exhibits created by inmates overseas. Also 19 exhibits were shortlisted from 178 paintings collected from our painting competition participated by inmates across all institutions and prisons of HK.

The purpose of this exhibition is to give the public and the relatives and friends of the inmates the opportunity to appreciate and understand the inner world of the inmates expressed through their artworks. What do they think about their reality? What is the vision for their life journey in future? I can't help praising their artistic talents to create so many beautiful artworks with limited resources behind bars. Their freedom of expression reaches no boundaries and their creation can never be shackled within the prison walls. Their dream reality and their fantasy world were well painted and ready for our appreciation. If provided with better equipment to match their sense of art, they would

definitely have made more masterpieces to stimulate our eyes.

The exhibition provided not only a stage for their creative artworks to be displayed, but also



an opportunity for me to curate how to show their paintings for better appreciation. In fact, how to present artistic works needs professional knowledge of curation. However, all I knew was just from watching a Korean drama about how the staff of an art museum selected and arranged paintings for exhibitions. I am humbly thankful for the opportunity to learn how to select a painting of quality and how to frame pictures and how to hang paintings for displaying. All skills needed to be used for making the exhibition meet with public aesthetic standards. In practice, our staff used a lot of effort to hang pictures firmly on thin wires as well as to post their captions nearby; their artworks deserved our best service. All effort paid was worth it when we saw that the visitors were highly appreciating our exhibition. I am most thankful to our God who keeps watching and protecting us all and appreciating our works for His glory.

Feedback from attendees



Fion and Hiu Ying (The Methodist Church-Sha Tin Church)

Visiting the "Hope Shines" exhibition really opened our eyes! Although the exhibition venue is not large, it allowed us to see many paintings and works of inmates from various places. There are many paintings in the venue that are eye-catching. Some of their paintings show the folk customs and cultures of different countries, some of them are very

three-dimensional, and some of them are meticulous, which is refreshing to see; there are also many paintings that display their faith in God and at the same time it can resonate between the painters and the visitors, allowing the visitors to better understand the meaning of the painters.

In addition, this exhibition not only has paintings to appreciate, but also promotes environmental awareness. One of their works used different waste materials to create an "Ark". The materials in it were all discarded wood, steel, and old car wheels. It allowed us to know more about the concept of environmental protection.



It is indeed not easy to draw a touching work. I believe that the experience of each inmate must far exceed what they have shown. I am so thankful to the inmates for their works which radiate light in darkness. Their paintings also light up the lives of those in other institutions.

I hope there will be more exhibitions like this in the years to come and thank you to Kun Sun for organizing this event that enable us all to understand the innermost thoughts of the inmates.

Dabbie (Kowloon Tong Alliance Church)

The freedom of thought cannot be trapped by walls. From the art works of inmates and rehabilitated persons, I clearly see the sky and the universe in their minds. The exhibition of "Hope Shines" serves as a medium of contact; there is no longer any form of estrangement among peoples. The inmates use art works to speak for them and represent their emotions.

In the exhibition, I saw a painting titled "Getting Free," depicting a pair of handcuffs as a token of being locked on one hand and on the other depicting a pigeon linking to a chain flying freely at the end. The image is simple but the meaning is deep.



Another painting with the name, "God" is depicting the theme to long for God and with the description, God is always with me. In this painting there is a woman kneeling down in prayer. Although the woman's face is covered by her prayerful hands, her body language reveals that she wants to see Jesus, who is at the same time looking at her in prayer. The whole content of this painting makes me feel that she persists in faith to seek God and is continuously in God's comfort despite the difficulties of losing her freedom in jail.

Furthermore, feelings of hope arose when looking at a painting with the title "The Sun Will Rise Again" the content depicts a man in tears kneeling inside an iron cage while watching a white dove flying away with the key for the cage. I can clearly understand what is in the painter's mind - his inner pain that it is hard not to feel for him.

Although all the paintings in "Hope Shines" exhibition are not masterpieces, they have the power to move peoples' hearts. With a heart eager for faith and freedom, the painters use delicate brushwork to connect to people outside the prison, so that people viewing their works can understand how they feel.

Florence (Development Director – MilkandHoney Arts)

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic in 2020, the entire city and even the world seemed to come into a halt. Although the situation was less severe in the second half of the year, many activities planned long ago had to be cancelled due to too many uncertainties. Apart from feeling disappointed, I often felt disoriented. However, what I am thankful is having more time to pray and learn to wait quietly. In October, I received an invitation to an exhibition run by KSA, one of my ministry partners. I was glad that the well-prepared "Hope Shines" art exhibition of the inmates and rehabilitated persons could be held as scheduled. I was really excited for the exhibition!

At the opening ceremony, many KSA staff like Pastor Esther and John Lo were quite familiar to me and also I felt the warmth of their team of coworkers and volunteers and enjoyed this reunion opportunity. Looking at the art works closely, one can feel that the inmates are so eager to tell their life stories through paintings. As in the past, every time we visited prisons, the volunteers and I often learned a lot from their life experiences. This time, the expressions through their artistic works were also deeply encouraging. Two works in the exhibition particularly touched me, and they also allowed us to see the faithfulness of God's words and the power of the gospel to transform lives. The creation of the handicrafted wood boat, the Renewed Vessel, was inspired by the story of the biblical figure Jonah (Jonah 2:5-7), which was actually addressing about my situation right on time. The message of other painting, in The Sun Will Rise Again: "There's always Hope in every hardship and there's a Sunshine after the storm," also touched me deeply and was created by Shane Valdez who was an inmate of other nations.

I pray with hope that KSA will bring more lives back to the path of God!




Title: The Sun Will Rise Again **Author:** Shane Valdez




