主席的話

乍看之下保羅好像有點自大，但如果我們明白人的行為是從學習和模仿而來的，就會同意保羅對他的屬靈兒說的話。所有動物差不多都是從父母身上學習生存的所需知識和技巧，而學習所需時間是和生活環境的複雜程度成正比。

在香港，有些兒童由於父母工時長沒時間和精力，或父母自己成長過程中未曾得到父母適當的教導等原因，以致沒能給他們所需的陪伴和教導，結果就是造成惡性循環。所以十年前政府大力推動兒童師友計劃，讓有心的人士成為這些兒童的同行者，帶領他們能有較好的成長。這個師友計劃得教會的支持，為不少兒童帶來祝福。

不過，香港有一群兒童比一般兒童面對更為困難的情況——他們的父或母是在服刑當中。這些兒童不單失去了重要的陪伴和教導，甚至很困難去理解和面對父母在囚的事實。這

些兒童需要特別的關懷照顧，所以兩年前我們開展了特別為囚友子女而設的師友計劃，並且加大了家庭事工的投放。由於得義工積極參與和基金的經濟支持，這些兒童在心靈和

物質供應上的匱乏得到若干程度的改善。

在這裏我們除了感謝主給我們這個看見外，還要感謝與我們伙伴合作的「優質師友網絡」、參與的義工和大力支持我們的One Accord

更新會師友同行計劃分享

推行計劃原因及第一、二屆師友計劃發展情況

當家庭發生巨變，孩子們便會頓失依靠。同樣家中父母其中一方入獄，小孩子的照顧便落入其中一個家長或家中長輩手中。因為忙於照顧家務及小朋友需要，小朋友的學習及成長需要通常很容易被忽略。他們如果長期被缺乏照顧，便很容易學壞或誤入歧途，那麼一代又一代都不能脫離罪的枷鎖。

為了提早介入及支援囚友家庭的需要，更新會除了在懲教院所提供院內的宗教班以外，還有院外服務，如：男、女宿舍、家庭事工等。家庭事工設立目的，是為在囚或更生人士家庭提供緊急支援、家庭及心理輔導、探訪，又為合資格的小孩提供教育基金申請。我們透過基督的愛、持續的關懷牧養，讓囚友或更生人士家庭不致因害怕社會的標籤定型而隱藏於社區中，他們的小孩子也能在學習及成長上得到適切支援。鑑於有需要的家庭為數不少，我們需要更多義工、更有系統及更有效資源分配來關顧在囚或更生人士的家庭及小朋友發展需要。因此我們希望透過採用師友計劃(Mentorship)這理念去推動本會的家庭事工，讓更多孩子被關愛及接納。

我們於2017年7月開辦第一屆「師友同行計劃」，招募了大約10位更新會義工成為「友師」及12位囚友/更生人士子女成為「友員」。透過每月一次的會面及活動，我們希望「友員」小朋友能與「友師」建立一個穩定及信任的關係。「友師」於計劃舉辦前及舉行期間需要接受為期一年(4次)由本會與「優質師友網絡」(QMN)合辦的培訓(同工於下列再作詳細分享)。第一屆「師友同行計劃」已進

入第二年，「友師」與「友員」已建立穩定及互信的關係，家長和小朋友的反應也非常良好。

另外，第二屆「師友同行計劃」亦於2019年1月開展，有16位「友師」及18位「友員」參加，我們已帶領各「友師」探訪「友員」家庭。由5月份起，「友師」便開始每月一次與「友員」往外出活動。

我們於7月13日(六)舉行兩屆的「師友同行計劃」聯合重聚日，有60位家長、小朋友及「友師」報名出席，我們很高興在這個暑假讓各「友師」、「友員」及家長一起歡聚。

每一屆的「師友同行計劃」為期三年，建立「友師」與「友員」的關係只是第一步，我們期望讓「友師」有更長時間了解小孩子及家庭的需要，與「友員」訂立成長目標。

「友師」訓練及困難

「師友同行計劃」是更新會家庭事工的一項嶄新計劃，計劃從一開始構思、推行到發展至第二屆，很高興一直有「優質師友網絡」（下稱QMN）成為我們的合作夥伴。QMN與更新會有著相同理念，希望發展在囚及更生人士子女的師友計劃，幫助更多有需要的兒童及家庭。每一屆的「友師」都有四次的優質培訓課程，透過QMN為「友師」提供訓練，讓「友師」充份了解計劃的願景、意義和內容，並按著計劃的要求，反思自己，逐步掌握自己的角色，為「友員」及其家庭所遇到的困難和挑戰提供有方向目標的支援及關顧，成為這些家庭重要的一員。

大部份「友師」是更新會服務多年的義工，雖然是資深義工，但面對「友員」及其家庭也會遇到一定困難挑戰，例如：「友師」未能與「友員」及其家庭建立互信、沒有足夠的知識、經驗及突發危機情況等…所以每一次的培訓，都會針對「友師」與「友員」的進度及現況而設計「貼身」的內容。QMN就為我們提供專業督導與支援服務，教導建立關係的階段、實用的溝通技巧、兒童的認知發展、社會心理發展階段、危機介入處理等。讓「友師」知道必須按「友員」的成長需要適時更新嚮導目標，師友互信關係能夠持續發展。在計劃進行的過程中，經歷成長的不只「友員」，還有「友師」自己，除了令「友員」引起

興趣，也享受做「友師」的樂趣。我們期望讓「友師」、「友員」家庭能夠從師友計劃一同得益成長。

過去兩年，我們感恩看見第一屆的「友師」與「友員」從萌芽期的關係建立，「友師」以開放及接納的態度持續認識「友員」，向「友員」展示真誠，為「友員」製造安全感。師友中間經歷挑戰期，經過討論成長目標，調適雙方的期望，現在逐漸步入穩定期。「友師」除了非常關顧「友員」，建立促進「友員」成長的人際關係，當計劃進入第二年，「友師」更會以「友員家庭為本」的服務為目標，為「友員」家庭提供情感及資源支援。到第三年，希望可因應「友員」及家庭的成長歷程需要，持續提供個人化的成長目標計劃。培訓亦會以個案討論形式，讓不同「友師」提出「友員」的情況，透過討論分析，一同回饋，一同學習，將會是更貼身的培訓。

盼望孩子及家庭有更長遠的成長改變，「友師」不只在計劃的三年內，日後繼續成為「友員」家庭的重要一員，就像在院所的服侍，從認識所員到所員離院，建立一份可以細水長流的關係。

Chairman's Message

"Join together in following my example, brothers and sisters, and just as you have us as a model, keep your eyes on those who live as we do." Philippians 3:17

Paul seems a bit arrogant. But we will agree with what Paul said to his spiritual brothers and sisters, if we understand that human behaviour comes from learning and imitation. One can observe that animals learn knowledge and skills from their parents, and the time required for learning is directly proportional to the complexity of the living environment.

In Hong Kong, some parents fail to give their children the necessary companionship and guidance they need because they have no time and energy due to long working hours, or they have not been properly taught by their own parents throughout their own childhood. It then becomes a vicious circle. Therefore, ten years ago, the government started promoting

children's mentorship programs, so that those who are committed could become the mentors of these children and support them to grow up to maturity. This mentorship program is supported by many churches and brings blessings to many children.

However, in Hong Kong, there is a group of children who are more difficult than ordinary children - their

parents are in prison. These children not only lose important companionship and teaching, but even have difficulty in understanding and facing the fact that their parents are in prison. These children need special care, so two years ago we launched a mentorship program specifically for the children of prisoners and increased the support for family ministries. Due to the active participation of volunteers and the financial support of the fund, there has been an increase in spiritual and material resources for these children.

In addition to thanking the Lord for giving us this vision, we also thank our partner "Quality Mentorship Network", the volunteers who have participated in the program and the One Accord Charity Foundation that have provided great support for us. We do our best to implement this mission given to us.

KSA Mentorship Programs

Reason for launching the Mentorship program and the development of the first and second program

Ms. Charlotte Chen (Senior Ministry Officer)

When there are dramatic changes in the family, the children are the ones that lose out. If a parent is in jail, the care of children falls into the hands of the other parent or senior members of the family. The children's learning and welfare can be easily overlooked in the need for housework or childcare. If children are neglected for any period of time, they could easily go astray. Then generations become trapped in the shackles of sin.

In order to intervene early and support the needs of the prisoners' families, KSA provides aftercare services, such as male and female dormitories and family ministry. The purpose of family ministry is to provide emergency support, family and psychological counseling, visits to families in prison, and apply for educational funding for eligible children. We provide Christian love and continuous care to families of prisoners and their families who are hidden in the community because they are afraid of social labeling. Their children can also receive appropriate support for their study and growth. In view of the large number of families in need, we require more volunteers, and more systematic and efficient allocation of resources to cater for the needs of families and children in prison. Therefore, we hope to promote our family ministry by adopting the concept of mentorship, so that more children can be cared for and accepted.

In July 2017, the first mentorship program was launched. In the first program, we recruited about 10 volunteers to become mentors and 12 children of prisoners/rehabilitated person to be mentees. Through monthly activities, we hoped that these children could build trust and develop a stable relationship with their mentors. Mentors also needed to receive four training sessions within one year by the Quality Mentorship Network (QMN). The first mentorship program

has entered its second year. Mentors and Mentees have established a stable and trusting relationship and have drawn positive comments from both parents and children.

The second mentorship program commenced in January 2019, with 16 mentors and 18 mentees. We took our mentors to visit mentees and their families. Our mentors started to meet with mentees once a month from May.

We also held a reunion on 13 July for mentors and mentees of the first and second mentorship program. Sixty parents, children and mentors took part in this event. We were happy to bring together mentors, mentees, and their parents during the summer vacation.

Building a relationship is only the first step. The whole Mentorship Program will last for three years, so we mentors can have a longer time to understand the needs of children and their families, and set goals for growth with the mentees.

“Mentors” – Training & Difficulties

The Mentorship Program is a brand new project in our family ministry. It is a pleasure to have “Quality Mentorship Network” (hereinafter QMN) as our partner starting from the project idea to the implementation of the two programs. QMN has the same philosophy as KSA, which hopes to develop its own mentoring program for the children of prisoners and rehabilitated persons to help more children and families in need. We have had four training sessions for mentors. Through the training provided by QMN, the volunteers can fully understand our vision, the content of the program, and be self-reflective about their role in the program, which is to provide support and care for mentees and their families through difficulties and challenges.

Most of the mentors are volunteers who have been serving KSA for many years. Although they may be seasoned volunteers, they face certain difficulties in serving their mentees and their families. For example, mentors find it difficult to establish mutual trust with mentees and their families as they have insufficient knowledge and experience to handle sudden crisis situations. Therefore, every training session has to be tailor-made for the current situation of mentors and also mentees. QMN provides professional supervision and support services, educates about the stages of establishing relationships, practical communication skills, children’s cognitive development, psychosocial development stages, and crisis management. These enable the mentors to review how they monitor the growth of the mentees, so the trust and the relationship between mentor and mentee can continue to develop. Not only mentees experienced growth in the program, mentors also grow as they participate in the

program. Mentors not only bring new experiences and fun to the mentees, but mentors also enjoy the fun of being a friend of the mentees. We also hope that the family of mentees can grow together through the Mentorship Program.

In the past two years, we have been grateful to see the growth in the relationship between mentors and mentees. At the beginning, mentors showed their sincerity to the mentees and continued getting to know the mentees in an open and accepting manner. This created a sense of security for the mentees. At the middle stage, there was a challenging period, where growth goals were discussed as well as adjusting the expectations of both parties. Then we gradually entered a stable period. The mentors not only care for mentees, they establish interpersonal relationships with them. In the second year, we are more “mentees and family-oriented”, with mentors providing emotional and resource support for families. In the third year, we hope to continue to provide personalized growth goals in response to the growing needs of our mentees and families. The training will also be conducted in the form of case discussions, so that different mentors can raise the individual situations of mentees. Through discussion and analysis, giving back together and learning together more personalized training can be developed.

We hope that children and families will have longer-term growth and change. Mentors will continue to be an important member of the mentee’s family. It is like being in the correctional institution, it can take up till you leave the correctional institution to establish a relationship to get to know others well.
