這是我第一次寫信給大家,因為我擔心這幾個月,因疫 情影響,更新會的同工和義工都不能進入懲教所和大家 見面,大家會有好像被遺忘的感覺。我希望告訴大家, 無論在任何情況之下,同工和義工和你們一樣焦急期望 疫情好轉,以致可以再一次和大家聚會。

在這次疫情影響之下,香 港的各行各業都遭受到沉 重的打擊,許多人都面對 經濟的壓力。許多福音機 構都擔心奉獻會大大減少, 以致事工缺乏經費・甚至 支付同工的薪水也成問題。 感恩這些日子主給更新會 足夠的奉獻,也多了人關 心查詢我們的狀況。我想這 固然是因這許多人對更新 會有感情,但更重要的是 他們關心我們所服侍的對

戰老兵摩爾上尉因為感謝 國民醫療一直給他很多幫 助,故此決定要在100歲生 日前,在自家後花園走100 遍,盼能幫醫護人員募款 1000英鎊。摩爾結果一共 籌得超過2900萬英鎊・超 過135萬人參與捐獻。健力 士世界紀錄已經宣布,摩 爾的成績打破了個人慈善 行走籌款最高紀錄。

摩爾能做的有限,只是靠 著助行器緩慢地短距離步 行,但他的心靈卻超越了 自己有限的外在條件。令 人感動的不是他能籌到多 少金錢,是他那感恩和願 意做點什麼的心所引發的 影響 - 135萬人參與捐獻 和不少年長和身體有限制 的人仿效他進行籌款。

各位所員是生活在極大的 限制中・我希望你們的心 靈不會因此萎縮,因為主 的復活告訴我們,上帝的 愛能夠衝破一切限制,而 我們信主的人也因得著這 份愛,可以衝破自己的限 制,去表達對人的愛。

記得在2009年的一個晚上,我跟 義工及更生人士在一個禱告祭壇 為監獄群體來禱告;當晚神大大

禱告會之後,我心裏就生出一個異象:要為這些「黑手」 女性更生人士建立一個「家」,讓她們可以安穩,調整, 重建,發展。2010年,更新會開辦了第一個女性宿舍,為 這些不斷進出監獄的「黑手」姊妹們提供一個全人牧養的

十年盡是感恩;感謝主賜給我 們美好的服侍團隊,2016年又 獲「主恩澤森慈善基金會」捐 贈舍址給我們。這十年,入住 了舍友70人,當中最高紀錄的是 入獄20多次,舍友完成了住宿

訓練離舍,到今天有六成的人沒有再次入獄和重新吸毒, 她們有了正常的生活和工作,也與家人復和。其中10位姊 妹畢業後被訓練成為助理舍監,也有8位姊妹現今在教會/福 音機構/社福機構中工作。

在這個神興起的平台上,許多千瘡百孔的生命,經歷了修復 和蜕變,完全因著父神不放棄的愛和聖靈復活的大能,這份 愛是我不能明白的,卻深深敬畏。

女宿舍的第一個舍址是在荃灣一幢大廈的23樓3室,所以我 們就宣告詩篇23:3是神給我們女宿舍這個屬靈家庭的應許。

神不單止拯救了我這個「道友」和入獄14次的積犯,還調 教好了我的人生態度。

2012年中,離開喜靈洲女戒毒所(勵顧懲教所)後,便毅然入住更新會女宿舍,決意從新做人。

宿舍生活總離不開聖經的 教導,若用心學習,倒是 有趣的。每天在舍監帶領 下靈修、讀經、唱詩歌等 等,融合所學習到的,為 自己打好根基,將來也能 站立得穩。

日常中,舍友間爭吵有時,傾心有時,透過相處和磨合,彼 此扶持著同行。牧者、舍監、其他弟兄姊妹的熱心服侍,使 我大大感受到天父偉大的愛,我內心的高牆也漸被拆毀,願 意敞開和放下自己,學習為別人著想。

期間,被安排參加團契,當中包括不同的課堂(尤其有關溝通方面),真是獲益良多,成為日常的幫助。我也藉著做義工的機會,學習正常社交,接觸不同界別人士。其後,感恩獲教會聘用為半職幹事,處理文書的工作。這三年間,一邊工作,一邊學習,是為將來走更遠的路作準備。

另一方面,家人知道我的改變後,也原諒了我,已破裂的關係亦得以修補。於2014年初,我便離開宿舍,搬回與家人同住享天倫。

2016年,神賜我異象服侍別的群體,我便走出安舒區,轉往服務智障人士的展能中心工作。在完全陌生的環境下,我仍勇於接受這新挑戰,因為,我知道父神必保護我,為我開路。面對智障人士,除非他們有攻擊性行為,需要格外留心之外,就是以耶穌的大愛愛護他們,適應之後,我亦以每天照顧他們為樂。而同事之間,人多口雜,感恩還記得初入宿舍時學到的「口出恩言」,及其他上帝的訓勉,真的可以大派用場呢。

耶穌怎樣饒恕我、給我機會、愛我,我都願意學習以祂的方式待人。常提醒自己以寬恕及體諒的心、存謙卑的態度對人,口要慎言,總以溫柔回應,最重要聆聽聖靈的提醒,要內省自己,有錯就要認,這樣,自然生活或工作都樂在其中。

回想每個階段有父神的帶領,感恩有更新會宿舍,給我一個 緩衝的時間和地方,學習真理鞏固步伐,遇著風浪亦不致被 淹沒,反而能夠乘風破浪。祝願大家,捉緊福音,邁向美好 的將來!

宿舍之後(見証二) 我成了助理舍監 佩儀

我過去是個吸毒者,曾出入監獄15次,非常自我中心,任性 反叛,不理別人感受,最重要「自己好受」,絕不認錯,自 小到大都不聽勸告,脾氣暴躁,常動手打人。

2016年我在監獄內的更新會宗教班認識耶穌,每次上宗教班都感動流淚,非常平安,很想改過,所以我在2017年4月出獄便入住更新會女宿舍,決心要戒毒戒煙戒粗口;但我在第二天,卻為了吸煙而偷走,但那次我吸煙後非常辛苦,並很後悔,我想回到宿舍,當時舍監給了我一次機會,當我回到宿舍就立刻嘔吐了,我知道是主幫助我,令我對吸煙抗拒反感,自那次之後,我便專心一意留在宿舍了。期間每一個舍監都幫助我,教導我放低自我,重新學習,宿舍每個姊妹都很有愛,好像家人一樣,互相包容學習,因為每個人都想改過。宿舍每日靈修,非常好,聖經的每句説話都是真理,教導我們學義,不要作惡,以愛還愛,要饒恕人,令我的人生價值觀完全改變,很有喜樂和盼望。



住滿三個月後,宿 舍安排我到教會做 義工,服侍老人家, 這是我第一次做義 工,很開心很有意 義。2018年12月25

日我在這間教會接受洗禮,每位弟兄姊妹都很接納我關心 我,直到現在我還在教會做義工。

在宿舍時,我們每逢星期三都會回更新會的阿尼西母訓練,參加的弟兄姊妹都是更生人士,完全沒有隔膜很有親切感,大家互相關懷鼓勵,每次課堂都很充實和有很多方面的學習。2019年4月我成為阿尼西母受訓學員,後來更作了學員中的班長,又被委派在女宿舍學習做助理舍監,我得到許多學習的機會:主動關心別人、包容體諒、互相守望代禱、管理事務、團隊合作、教導宿舍姊妹我更要有溫柔謙卑的心。

在宿舍時我們都要修讀生命轉化課程,主在課堂中醫治我的心靈,令我對媽媽一直的憎恨化解了,也給我看到自己的錯,我現在對家人的態度不再一樣,很重視家人,懂得用愛去關心他們,家人已接納我,讓我搬回家與姊姊同住。以前的我只會重視朋友不回家,但現在我珍惜跟家人相聚的時候,十分開心。

主給我的使命是服侍更生人士,希望自己的生命能影響生命,願人人悔改跟隨主;我深深感謝神和人給我的恩惠,願 我這生能榮神益人!

Chairman's Message To all inmate brothers and sisters,

May the peace of the Lord be with you!

This is the first time I have written to you because I am worried that you may feel forgotten due to the coronavirus situation neither the co-workers nor volunteers have been able to enter the institutions to meet with you. I want to tell you that despite these circumstances, co-workers and volunteers are looking forward to the epidemic situation improving so that we can meet with you again.

Affected by this epidemic, the whole financial environment in Hong Kong has been hit hard, and many people are facing economic pressures. Many evangelical organizations worry about the decrease of donations, so they will face a lack of funding for the ministry, and even have a problem paying the salary of co-workers. We are grateful that the Lord has given enough donation to Kun Sun these days, and even more people have cared and asked about our situation. I think this is because many people have connected with Kun Sun for a long time, but more importantly, they didn't want you all to not be served because of insufficient funding for the organization. I believe that many of these donors are not very rich nor people who do not need to face the impact of economic down-

sizing, but they mostly will not keep focusing on the difficulties they face, just like the Bible says: we treat the giving as gain. The ministry serving you is part of their lives, so they care about your well being, and hope to support you by supporting Kun Sun. When the co-workers told me about the donation received, I was really touched and immediately said: I must write to you and tell you not to be discouraged because of the suspend of meetings, because the people who love you are always concerned about you.

Another thing I want to share with you is a news story. A 99-year-old World War II veteran Captain Tom Moore wanted to thank the British National Health Service for their help. Therefore, he decided to walk 100 times in his back garden before his 100th birthday to raise 1,000 pounds for the medical staff. Finally Moore raised more than 29 million pounds, and more than 1.35 million people participated in the donation. The Guinness World Records has announced that Moore's achievements have broken the record of the highest amount raised by an individual through a charity walk.

What Moore can do is only walk slowly with his walker, but his mind is



beyond the limited external conditions. What is touching is not how much money he raised, but the impact of his gratitude and willingness to do

something - influencing 1.35 million people to participate in donations and motivating other people who are not young and have physical limitations to raise funds.

All of you are living under great restrictions, but I hope that your hearts will not be shaken by this because of the resurrection of the Lord we can rejoice. God's love can break through all restrictions. And we have all received His love, so you can try to break through your own restrictions and express love for others.

May the resurrection love of the Lord protect your body, heart, and souls. And we will soon meet again and share our gratitude together when the epidemic has passed.

The unbelievable love from God

One evening in 2009, I prayed with volunteers and rehabilitated persons for the prisoners at a prayer meeting. God greatly impacted my heart and I was prompted to cry out for the "black hand" prisoners in the female prison. These inmates have repeatedly gone in and out of the prison for many years, they have many struggles and feel hopeless, tired, numb, and are often wanting to give up. But God said firmly and strongly: "I will never give up on them! I want to restore their beauty to how I created them at first."

After the prayer meeting, I had a vision in my heart: to build a "home" for these "black hand" female prisoners, so that they could adjust to society and rebuild their lives. In November 2010, KSA established the first female hostel to provide a wholistic shepherding house for "black hand" sisters who are the prison's "regular customers".



Today's Female Hostel

These ten years have been filled with gratitude. We thank the Lord for giving us a wonderful ministry team and also the "Abundant Grace Charity Foundation" that donated a flat for the female hostel in 2016.

In the past ten years, 70 people have stayed in the hostel. Among them, the most troubled one has been imprisoned 20 times. 60% of the rehabilitated sisters who have finished hostel training and left the hostel have not gone back to jail or re-take drugs again until today. They live a normal life and are reconciled with their families. There are 10 sisters who have been trained as assistant hostel wardens, and 8 sisters are currently working in churches/evangelical organizations/social welfare organizations.

On this platform where God has risen, many lives with flaws have undergone restoration and transform. This is totally due to the love of our Father who does not give up on them.

God's promise

The first location of the "female hostel" was at Room 3, 23/F of a building in Tsuen Wan. So we declared Psalm 23: 3 as God's promise for the female hostel.

These promises have been fulfilled continuously over the past ten years, leading to the growth of the female hostel step by step. I have experienced a lot of ups and downs in serving the hostel in these last ten years. In the past, I was not willing to be a leader but only wanted to be a peer to the rehabilitated persons. However, God taught me to "become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ." (Ephesians 4:13). When I learned to be a leader, I had to face the managing of the hostel, shepherding the sisters, training the hostel wardens etc... all of these let me know

that I needed the Father's support and feeding. This helped me to go through the difficulties such as frequent hostel warden changes and the lack of shepherds. I'm thankful for the Lord's teaching in the past ten years.

The hostel is a platform for transforming life. Every resident is willing to let the Lord intervene, lead, and rewrite their lives into a beautiful testimony. The most important aim of the hostel is to help residents experience the power of the gospel, and follow Jesus Christ. They would experience

God not only saved me from drugs (I have been imprisoned 14 times), he has also adjusted my life attitude.

In mid-2012, after leaving the Addiction Treatment Centre at Hei Ling Chau (Nei Kwu Correctional Institution), I went to the KSA female hostel as I had decided to change, I wanted a new life.

Under the leadership of the wardens, we read the Bible and sing hymns every day. It provided me a solid ground for our rehabilitation life.

Although sometimes we have arguments, we usually share deeply and support each other. The care from pastors, wardens, and other brothers and sisters have made me feel the great love of the Heavenly Father,

my heart was warmed and I learned to care about others.

My family forgave me after seeing my changes, the broken relationship was repaired. At the beginning of 2014, I left the hostel and moved back to live with my family.

On the other hand, I was hired by a church as a half-time clerical staff. In the three years I served, I learned a lot for my career. In 2016, God gave me a new vision to serve a special group, the people with intellectual disability. Although it is completely new to me, I was still brave to accept this new challenge, because I knew that my Father would protect me and prepare for me. Taking care of intellectual disabled people, I need to be aware of their aggressive actions, but I love them with the love of Jesus. After some time to get adapted, I felt happy to take care of them every day. There are many colleagues in my working place, so sometimes there may be some gossip. But I remember the "blessing words" I learned in hostel, and other teachings from God which could be used in my working environment.

I am willing to treat other people as how Jesus do, He forgives me, gives me opportunities and loves me. I always remind myself to forgive and be considerate, humble to others, speak with blessings and always respond gently. The most important thing is to listen to the reminders of the Holy Spirit, to have self-reflection.

I am grateful for the hostel, giving me a buffer and a place to learn the truth and consolidate my learning. I wish you all to have a bright future!

After the hostel (testimony II) I became assistant warden-PuiYee

I used to be a drug addict. I have been in and out of the prison 15 times. I was very self-centered, rebellious, and ignored the feelings of others. I never admitted mistakes and never listened to the advice from others, I was triggered easily and often beat people.

I met Jesus in the religious class in prison in 2016. I cried every time in the religious class, I felt peaceful and I wanted to have changes in my life. So I moved into the KSA female hostel in April 2017 and was determined to quit drugs and smoking but I left hostel and smoked on the very next day. I felt regret so I phoned the warden to ask to go back to the hostel. The warden said she could gave me a chance. When I step into the hostel again, I threw up immediately, I knew it was the Lord who to help me revolt to smoking. All wardens helped me to change. I was surrounded by the love of every sister in the hostel, we lived together like a family. It is good to have spiritual learning every day, every word of the Bible is truth. God teaches us to choose correctly, to love others and to forgive people. God completely changed my values, I am very joyful and hopeful.



After living in the hostel for three months, the hostel supervisor arranged a volunteer service for me, to serve the elderly in a church. This is my first time to be a volunteer

and I am very happy as it is very meaningful. I was baptized in this church on December 25, 2018. Every brother and sister accept me and care about me, and I am still working as volunteer in the church until now.

We joined the Onesimus training of KSA every Wednesday when I stayed in the hostel. The brothers and sisters who participated are all rehabilitated persons. We learn together, care and support each other. I was assigned to train as an assistant warden. I learned to forgive, take care of others, pray for others, the management of a hostel, teamwork, and how to teach the sisters in the hostel with a gentle and humble heart.

We had to take a life transformation course when I stayed in hostel. The Lord healed my heart, my hatred of my mother was resolved, and I also saw my own faults. My attitude towards my family is no longer the same. I treasure my family and now know how to love them. My family has forgave me and allowed me back home to live with my sister.

The Lord gave me a mission to serve the rehabilitated person. I hope I can share with them my life so that they have strength to repent and follow the Lord. I am deeply grateful to God and others for their love and gifts. I hope that my life can be beneficial to others!
