來自家暴、破碎家庭

我出生於一個「很爛」的家庭,五兄姊均不是同父同母所出;酗酒的父親脾氣暴躁,經常嘈吵、摔東西和虐打家人,媽媽更是首當其衝的受害者。每一天當父親下班回來,全家就會進入緊張的狀態,兄弟姐妹都躲入房間;因為家中的混亂,兄弟姊妹的關係亦逐漸變得疏離,最後亦相繼離開家庭。而父母的關係更每況愈下,最後弄至離婚收場。他們離婚後,我們的撫養權歸媽媽所有,而我也開始變得反叛。

犯罪坐牢

當時12歲的我就因此離家出走,不再踏足校園,整天與 童黨為非作歹,更認識了村裡一些黑社會成員聯袂「搵 錢」,做一些破壞和犯法的事,如賣軟性毒品。那時認 為大家都是來自極差的家庭,一定會互相明白了解的。 但當一班同樣失意的人走在一起的時候,就想去做些『所 謂得意』的事,即是破壞和犯法的事。接著更正式加入 黑社會,開始以賣毒品、私煙、盜版光碟過生活。後 更自立門戶,自己拿貨、招攬人、開店一『錢滾錢』; 十七、八歲的時候更開始做壟斷地盤的生意,最終被 捕,在地區法院被裁定以三合會成員做了有組織的嚴重 罪行,判入獄五年,後改判刑兩年。

挑戰信仰的問題

坐牢時遇到監獄佈道事工的同工來探訪及傳福音,那時 我總喜歡挑戰他們,因我從小就讀基督教學校,認知上 知道很多有關耶穌的事,但從沒有真真正正地去認識或 經歷過這位耶穌。我常常滿腔忿怒與挑戰的態度對著探訪的同工說:『你説信耶穌生命會變豐盛,是否我現在信了就可以即時出獄?生命會有幾豐盛?我以前曾信耶穌的,家姐有帶我返過教會,但現在我卻在這裡啊,你說我生命豐盛嗎?」

第一天返教會

出獄後的我更花天酒地,仍繼續以往的生活方式,但卻 因著家中大家姐與姐夫對我的愛與關懷影響下,生命開始有轉機。在偶然的機會,大家姐與姐夫帶我上教會, 我當天精神狀態其實很差,因喝酒太多,整晚沒有睡好, 還帶著一身酒氣。雖然整個崇拜除了因為有音樂敬拜而 稍為清醒外,基本上其他時間都是睡著的,但心裡所感 覺到的平安和舒服是外面世界所沒有的。

回轉

經過了一段每星期日都跟著大家姐與姐夫上教會的時間,我開始思考我的生命,我盼望生命能有所轉變,我更感受到唯一的出路就是讓天父掌管我的生命,所以我決定靠著天父的力量放棄以往「很爛」的生活,努力離開舊有的圈子,作新造的人。經過一段艱難與爭扎的日子,靠著天父的恩典,我的生命開始進入另一個階段。天父不單重整了我的生命,更重整了我與家人的關係,從破碎的關係中,因著天父的愛被修補過來。

蒙召

在我生命回轉後我不斷經歷神的修剪,破碎和更新,以致我在日後的事奉路上得著更大的確據。回想起第一次的事奉是傳道人帶我到男童院去分享上帝在我身上的作為,就在分享的那天,神大大感動我;在院所裡我看到一大班男孩彷彿就看到從前的我,他們不斷反反覆獨才,他們不斷反反覆獨才,他們不斷反反覆獨才,他們得自由。當時在我心中有很大的催逼,巴不得馬上將耶穌如何使我得自由得生命的經歷和這些年青人分享,使他們知道唯有耶穌是他們唯一的出路。經過一段,在男童院服侍的時間,我發現我對年青人越來越有負擔,我每一次服侍完總是很期待下一次的來臨去服侍他們,我每一次服侍完總是很期待下一次的來臨去服侍他們,於是我開始求問神,求神給我印證和請教牧者,因為我知道事奉這條路不是隨便決定的事情,一旦決定了便要全然委身奉獻給神。

與此同時,我覺得對神的認識很不足,很想找一些神學或訓練課程來好好裝備自己,因為我覺得必須在多方面裝備,才能更全面服侍。正當我準備致電給我一個課程的單張,也向我介紹更新會一個名叫「阿尼西母訓練計劃」一專為更生人士及有心志事奉的所足四母訓練計劃」一專為更生人士及有心志事奉的弟兄兄妈妹所設的門徒訓練計劃。當時我忍不住哭了,深感天父給我的恩典與愛實在多而又多。經過祈禱和恩更,然給我的恩典與愛實在多加這個訓練計劃,很感思更,沒有對於實力。與我更加了解到同時我所在教會服侍青少年,期間我更加了解到可能發開始在教會服侍青少年,期間我更加了解到何對事本的過程中雖然有性所表。

經過這段時間的裝備和事奉操練,我更加清楚要全時間事奉上帝,所以與傳道和教會牧者商量後,我便開始了八年的攻讀神學之旅。在這八年接受裝備的時間裡神不斷從各方面陶造和破碎我,使我的人生得著很大的突破。

全時間事奉

今天的我已是一位傳道同工,主要負責青少年的事工,面對青少年的福音工作實在是充滿著無限的挑戰,他們亦好像我昔日般對信仰作出百般的挑戰:『信耶穌生命豐盛?前路都沒盼望……還說豐盛……!』但正正因為我經歷過這些疑惑與挑戰,因此可與他們分享:

『你問生命如何豐盛?看看我,從前沒有想過擁有的東西,甚至沒有辦法可擁有的基本需要,如簡單的一個家庭、愛、關懷和接納,但今天我靠著天父一一都擁有了,而生命中最豐盛的是『我們可以選擇』。以往沒有辦法作選擇,好像只能走在黑暗的道路上,但天父給了我一個重生的機會;更可貴的是天父給予我機會去服侍祂,召我回頭建立失喪的生命,並以生命影響生命。』

我相信神創造我們的時候,看我們為好的,雖然我們曾 因著過犯而受捆綁,但只要我們願意尋求天父,讓祂在 我們生命動工,並行走在祂的心意裡,同樣可以經歷豐 盛生命。願榮耀頌讚都歸給愛我們的天父。

適用於基督教機構及個人的"7S" 服務模式

簡單介紹

感謝和榮耀歸給神。"7S"服務模式是我撰寫的,靈感來自我每天閱讀聖經和實踐、持續專業研究、和超過40年在教育、警察服務和培訓領域所積累的工作經驗。我提議為同工和志願者安排兩個2小時的晚間研習會,來分享此主題,日期已定於4月26日和5月24日。我被邀請將相關的內容和經驗分三次在"更新"的期刊中與讀者分享。

在這次期刊我將介紹"7S"的內容,相關的聖經參考,一些聖經的應用,和給親愛的讀者們的作業實習,就是用"7S"服務模式來檢視機構/個人服務的情況。



在第二次和第三次期刊,我將解釋"7S"及聖十字的相互關係,引用一些聖經個案來説明這種服務模式,概括參與者在研習會的分享,如何以"7S"服務模式來加強機構/個人服務的事例和個案,和給讀者的應用實習。

"7S"的內容和相關的聖經參考

1 Spiritual 屬靈的	創世記1:1 (和合本)起初,神創造天地。2地是空虛混沌,淵面黑暗;神的靈運行在水面上。
2 Strategic 策略性	創世記1:3神説:「要有光」,就有了光。4神看光是好的,就把光暗分開了。
3 Systematic 系統性	創世記1:9神説:「天下的水要聚在一處,使旱地露出來。」事就這樣成了。 ¹¹ 上帝説:「地要發生青草和結種子的菜蔬,並結果子的樹木,各從其類,果子都包著核。」事就這樣成了。
4 Structural 結構性	創世記1:16於是神造了兩個大光,大的管畫,小的管夜,又造眾星。
5 Sincere 真誠的	約翰福音4:24神是個靈,所以拜他的必須用心靈和誠實拜他。」提摩提前書1:5但命令的總歸就是愛;這愛是從清潔的心和無虧的良心,無偽的信心生出來的。備註:無偽的與真誠的意思是一致(可參考英文本)
6 Skillful 靈巧的	但以理書1:17這四個少年人,神在各樣文字學問(學問:原文是智慧)上賜給他們聰明知識;但以理又明白各樣的異象和夢兆。9:22他指教我說:「但以理啊,現在我出來要使你有智慧,有聰明。備註:靈巧與智慧意思是一致(可參考英文本)
7 Strengthening 加力的	詩篇18:1耶和華,我的力量啊,我愛你!使徒行傳1:8但聖靈降臨在你們身上,你們就必得著能力,並要在耶路撒冷、猶太全地,和撒馬利亞,直到地極,作我的見證。」

上述經文告訴我們,神的靈參與了所有的創造,第一策略是帶來光,隨後的創作是分別出或造出系統性的各從其類和結構性的規律。主耶穌告訴我們,神是個靈,我們必須用心靈和誠實來敬拜他。技能/靈巧/智慧,能力或力量都是來自神。但以理,詩人,和所有使徒都以真誠來事奉神,並從神領受技能/靈巧/智慧,和力量來完成他們的服侍。

一些聖經應用

General Secretary Message From "Drop-Out" to "Drug-Trafficking"

At Easter this year, some volunteers and I have made a visit to Pik Uk Prison to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus. I really appreciated their sacrificial heart to serve on holiday, instead of spending time with their families. In fact, they needed to start the day even earlier than going back to offices; and to travel to such a far and remote cell. If it's not because of the love of God, and the burden of Holy Spirit, who would be willing to do so?

After finishing our worship, testimony and message sharing, we broke into groups and I had chance to talk to several guys at 30+. I asked them, "Do you have confidence that you won't come back here again after you are set free?' Some could reply quickly by saying, "Definitely not!" Some said, "I am not sure... but I will be smarter in the future". For those who replied "Definitely not", they probably have more than enough of the bitterness by losing their freedom. They would rather work harder physically outside and let their families have peace, than losing their dignity, freedom, or loved ones again. For those who said "I am not sure", I found that most of them have left schools early and become drug addicts when they were young. Reasons for their expulsion were bad conducts, criminal offences, etc. They always like to stay home just do nothing. They don't have any working skills but target to earn "quick money" by luck. Turning from a dropping-out student at junior high, to a drug-trafficker is exactly the true story of a rehabilitated brother in my church.

Would part-time drug trafficking a way of making a living?

I remember there was another time I talked to another group of youngsters anyone here not sent to prison for money?" Only one hand was up among the 8 persons, and I found that most of the inmates became drug traffickers only for just \$350-500 daily paid. When I asked them why they do not want to disclose the masterminds behind the scene, their answers were even more shocking by saying "it's the brotherhood bonding in triad society' or "it will make more people lose their jobs"... something worth for us to introspect. Does our government have to rely on the triad society to solve the drug and employment issue? Where are the influences of all entrepreneurs,

educators, sociologists and churches

For those who have low education yet have a skillset that can make a living, they usually are bad in money management and fond of play and eat. And in most cases they will end cohabitation and have children by accident. To support the families, they tend to find drug trafficking a way for making quick money. It would be even easier if one of them or both the couple were drug addicts. When they are caught, their children can only be put to custody of sponsored families, children's home or their grandparents. These "part-time drug trafficker" families are rising according to figures. Apart

from prayers, what else can we do? Are Christian's mature marriage and family virtue, and the "lives-to-lives" guiding model a new hope to amend the broken families of today?



Then young women will dance and be glad, young men and old as well. I will turn their mourning into gladness; I will give them comfort and joy instead of sorrow I will satisfy the priests with abundance, and my people will be filled with my bounty," declares the LORD. This is what the LORD says: "Restrain your voice from weeping and your eyes from tears, for your work will be rewarded," declares the LORD. "They will return from the land of the enemy (DRUG). Out Of Darkness Into The Light

"You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness." Ephesians 4:22-24



Broken Relationships

I grew up in a broken family with 5 other half siblings. My father was an alcoholic with a fiery temper. There was a lot of throwing things around and family violence. My mom was the ultimate victim of it all. The family would be on high alert and all children would hide in bedroom when my father returned home from work. The chaos drove a wedge in our relationship and we grew further and further away from each other. My parents eventually were divorced and my mom had custody of all children. All these brought the rebel out of me.

Behind Bars

I left home when I was 12 and used to hang out with other kids causing all sorts of troubles. We eventually hooked up with some gang members of a triad group and started a business to sell drugs. We were a group of kids who were lost, doing what we thought were right to gain what we have lost. Later, I officially joined the triad, started to sell drugs, fake DVDs and cigarettes for a living. I did so well that I established my own team and became a kingpin at the age of 17 or 18. I was finally arrested for the crimes I had committed and was sentenced for 5 years but later was reduced to 2.

Challenger Of Christianity

I went to a Christian school before and had some exposure of Christianity but never had the intention to know about it. While I was in jail, a team of prison ministry volunteers came to visit us. During each visit, I would challenge them with questions such as "If I believe in Christ now, would i be released right away?" "I used to believe in Jesus because my sister used to take me to church but look at where I am now? How abundant is my life now?"

First Day At Church

Followed my release, I went back to my old self except my lifestyle was worst than before. However, through the patience and love of my older sister and brother in-law, things started to take a better turn. One Sunday, they invited me to go to church with them. I had been drinking the night before and was far from being sober. I slept through most of the service except a few moments during praise and worship but the peace and love I felt in there was nothing I have ever felt before.

The Homecoming

After attending Sunday service with my sister and brother in-law for a while, I started to reflect on my life and realized that the only way to "clean up" was through Christ and God's grace and mercy. It was not an easy road but through God's grace, I began a new chapter of my life and He helped me to restore my relationships with my family.

The Calling

After I committed my life to Jesus, God has been disciplining me in every aspect so that I could share the challenges with others.

I remembered I was deeply touched by the Holy Spirit the first time I visited the children and juvenile home. I shared my experience with the boys and they reminded me of myself when I was their age. They were lost just like I was, and only God's grace and love could save and set them free. The more I visited them, the more I felt a calling to serve them. I understood that once I had responded to God's calling, I should serve with all my heart. So I started praying, asking God's confirmation if it was His will for me to serve these boys.

In the meantime, I wanted to learn more about God and equip myself so that I could serve Him better. Just as I was going to call a minister to enquire about theology courses, he called me first with information on a "Onesimus Integrated Training Scheme" because he felt that God wanted him to call me. I was so touched and broke down in tears because God was never short on His gifts and grace. I applied for the program and was so thankful that Kun Sun accepted my application. Later I was baptized and started serving in youth ministry. It taught me the right attitude to serve. It was not always easy but it was God's grace and calling that kept me going. After consulting with my pastor andminister at church, I studied theology for the next 8 years and throughout this period, God's discipline and teaching has brought about many life changing moments.

Serving Full Time

Today, I am minister involved in youth ministry. The challenges are numerous and like those I had before I came to know Christ. Such as "God gives us abundance of life? There is no hope so how can it be abundant?" But because I also had those doubts that I could share with them my experience. "If you want to know the meaning of abundance of life, then look at me. I once had nothing, not even the basic love and acceptance of a family, but by God's grace, I now have them all and the most abundant in life is the fact that "I have a choice". I did not choose wisely in the past and set off on the wrong path but God gave me a second chance; the more precious gift is that God gave me a chance to serve Him, to rebuild the life I once lost so to touch others with my own.

I believe when God created us, He saw that all was good. Even though we have sinned, but if we follow and surrender to Him and to do His will, we can also experience the abundance of life as He has intended for us. May all glory and praise be our beloved Heavenly Father.

The "75" Service Model for Christian Organizations & Individuals

Brief Introduction

Thanks and glory be to God. The "75" Service Model was written by me from the inspiration of my daily bible reading and practice, continuous professional studies and accumulated working experiences for over 40 years in the education, police services and training fields. I have proposed two 2-hour study sessions on this topic for fellow workers and volunteers in the evening on 26 April and 24 May. I was invited to share the contents and related experience with readers of Kun Sun in three issues.

In this issue, I will introduce contents of the "7S", relevant bible references, some biblical applications, practice and assignment for dear readers to review your organizational/personal service using the "7S" Service Model.

In the second and third issues, I will explain the inter-relations of "75" and the Holy Cross, quote some biblical cases to illustrate this service model, sum up sharing from participants of the study sessions, examples and cases on how to enhance organizational/personal service with "75" Service Model, and practice for readers.



Contents of the "75" and Relevant Bible References

Genesis 1:1 (NIV) In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. ² The earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters.
Genesis 1:3 And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. 4God saw that the light was good, and he separated the light from the darkness.
Genesis 1:9 And God said, "Let the water under the sky be gathered to one place, and let dry ground appear." And it was so. ¹¹ Then God said, "Let the land produce vegetation: seed-bearing plants and trees on the land that bear fruit with seed in it, according to their various kinds." And it was so.
Genesis 1:16 God made two great lights—the greater light to govern the day and the lesser light to govern the night. He also made the stars.
John 4:24(NIV) God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth." 1 Timothy 1:5 (NIV) The goal of this command is love, which comes from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith. N.B.: sincere and truth have similar meaning
Daniel 1:17 (KJV) As for these four children, God gave them knowledge and skill in all learning and wisdom: and Daniel had understanding in all visions and dreams. 9:22 And he informed me, and talked with me, and said, O Daniel, I am now come forth to give thee skill and understanding. Daniel 9:22 (NIV) He instructed me and said to me, "Daniel, I have now come to give you insight and understanding. N.B.: skill also means wisdom or insight

7 Strengthening Psalm 18:1 (NIV) I love you, LORD, my strength. Act 1:8 (NIV) But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

N.B.: strength and power have similar meaning

Above bible verses told us that the Spirit of God took part in all creations, bringing in light as the first strategy, subsequent creations were separated or made in systematic and structural orders according to their various kinds. Lord Jesus told us God is spirit, we must worship in the spirit and in truth with sincere faith. Skill or wisdom, Strength or power come from God. Daniel, Psalmist, and Apostles all served God sincerely, and received skill and strength from God in ministering their services.

Some Biblical Applications

Spiritual Strategy and Systematic Structure with Sincerity, Skill and Strength

(1) Lord Jesus in choosing apostles and sending them

Luke 6:12 (NIV) One of those days Jesus went out to a mountainside to pray, and spent the night praying to God. ¹³When morning came, he called his disciples to him and chose twelve of

them, whom he also designated apostles. 9:1 When Jesus had called the Twelve together, he gave them power and authority to drive out all demons and to cure diseases, ² and he sent them out to proclaim the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.

Matthew 10:16 (KJV) Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.

(2) Lord appointed seventy other disciples

Luke 10:1 (NIV) After this the Lord appointed seventy others and sent them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go. ²He told them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.

(3) Lord's mission for disciples

Act 1:8 (NIV) But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Practice and Assignment

Review your personal service and service of your organization using the "75" Service Model, and answer the following questions:

1 Spiritual	Do you maintain worshipping God in spirit and in truth? Have you invited God's Spirit to guide your service? Have you followed God's spiritual teaching in performing your service?
2 Strategic	Nowadays, there are many business strategies, but are they in line with the spiritual principles? Do you have any spiritual strategy in guiding your service?
3 Systematic	Is your service arranged according to spiritual strategy and systems?
4 Structural	Is your service well-structured in line with spiritual principles?
5 Sincere	Are you sincere in your service? Can your sincerity be felt by your clients or people encountered?
6 Skillful	Do you have the necessary skills and wisdom in performing your service?
7 Strengthening	Do you have strength throughout your service or you feel wear-out or even burn-out? Can your service strengthen your clients or people encountered?

During your review pray to God for shower of blessing on how to enhance and strengthen your service in line with the "75" Service Model. *Psalm 90:16(NIV) May your deeds be shown to your servants, your splendor to their children.* ¹⁷ May the favour of the Lord our God rest on us; establish the work of our hands for us—yes, establish the work of our hands.
