今期內容分享到幾位經歷5、6年折騰,才上訴得席的嚴 重毒品案姊妹的見證,不禁為在更新會已服侍10年的同 工『阿珊』感恩。雖然她們的案件背景不同,但都一同在 獄中經歷神:阿珊是少不更事,因接觸毒品,挺而走險犯

事而被判4年半刑期;幾位國內女士是在毫不知情下,被騙攜帶藏有毒品的行李過 境,因此被判刑10年以上,幸而經多番搜證、追尋原兇才證明她們是受害者。但 她們都是於在囚時認識神、信主,阿珊更在刑釋後接受更新會的職業訓練繼而成為 同工,有其他同工陪伴她重投自由生活、建立工作和教會生活,更重要是如何撫養 教育單親的兒子成長。由於有幾位生命導師同行,她們母子倆教會生活穩定,跟導 師們關係亦師亦友,經常相約聚餐旅遊,阿珊更經常與其他同工到懲教機構及教會 分享見證。一班同工們在這些姊妹需要支援時,以關愛和使人有盼望的福音介入, 藉著禱告交託, 聖經中, 神話語的應許, 伴她們過渡人生最艱苦漫長的日子。

近十年八載很多跨國販毒集 園,層出不窮地施展毒招, 使一些入世未深的青少年、 疏於防範而又樂意助人的 人、知識水平和人均收入較 低的國家人民等・墮入他們 所設的圈套而瑯璫入獄,-下子便斷送了10年或以上 的自由生活。當然亦有一些 真正貧圖賺快錢之人・雖得 失賺蝕心自知,但的確令販 毒案件日趨嚴重。最近・有 認識的教牧夫婦在外國讀書 的孩子,在當地任職兼職送 貨員時・也誤嶞販毒圏套而 入獄・真是防不勝防。根據 警方網上資料,2007-09年 的嚴重毒品案件・每年平均 約2800宗・而2010-16年每

平均約2000宗,這是否意 味著初期很多人因對毒販的 圈套技倆無知而繫獄?往後 幾年是否因政府對防犯毒販 招式的公民教育增強了,而 降低了該類犯案率?那就有 待考究了。

二月下旬,同工在寧靜的大 嶼山衛理園舉行了2天的退修 營會·讓大家透過進入「明 陣」中思考及描繪圖像,靜 思過去一年與神、與人、與 己的關係,探求未來事工的 方向・個人得益不少・同工 也彼此加深了認識。有趣的 是同工在集體遊戲中非常投 入・不停在主持人宣讀的遊 戲規則中・尋找字裡行間的 漏洞,圖求取得優勢獲勝, 行為與一些罪犯企圖「走法 律罅」無異・將人性陰暗-面表露無遺,但當然這些行 徑往往都只會招致失敗。





三月廿八日晚上的同工義工 聯合祈禱會,招聚了多間參 與復活節院所佈道的教會的 弟兄姊妹來到更新會,為節 期中30多間院所的佈道聚 會能順利舉行進行禱告。不 同教會的代表因而稍略認 識・各教會義工及同工彼此 記念代禱。聚會在交淺言深 的氣氛中結束,同等候節期 佈道日的重聚和收割。

令人防不勝防的販毒陷阱?

在過去七、八年間,已發生大約三十宗國內女子途經香港各關口時,因販運危險药物被拘捕的個案。由於她們攜帶的毒品,都是以海洛英或純度高的冰毒為主,而且份量十分多,往往價值超過港幣一二百萬元,所以案件一旦被判罪名成立,她們往往都要面對10年以上、甚至接近30年的監禁刑期!

在這些個案中,大部份女士都是被在國內認識的黑人男士利用,這些男士主要透過國內的QQ網絡結識女性,或刻意接觸女性售貨員、採購員、翻譯員、學生等,他們會自稱經營外貿、批發服裝的生意,經常要穿梭世界各地。首先,他們會設法與國內女子混熟,或以男女朋友關係取悦對方,建立信任後,便會誘騙她們到馬來西亞、印尼、越南、泰國、非洲等地一起旅遊或隨行「公幹」攜取樣辦回國。但最終,這些黑人男士會以不同藉口不出現或提早離開,促使國內女子自行將表面是樣辦衣服、雜物的行李箱帶回國。而在這些由他人提供的行李箱內,往往會發現暗格藏有毒品,又或在書本、電器用品內藏毒。

三十多宗個案中,當中有無罪釋放的,亦有罪名成立的, 還有正在等候上訴的。幸而,部份個案的姊妹在香港等候

審訊或服刑期間,在院所內參加宗教班,認識神,亦經歷神的同在。

但根據了解,直至今天為止,暫時未有一個涉案黑人男子被捕。相信可能因為證據上的舉證問題,亦可能因兩地的執法、調查及檢控上,雙方的基礎上有所不同。所以這些黑人男子很可能仍然會繼續在廣州一帶或中國任何一個地方,設法尋找他們的下一個目標!

沒想到一次旅行可以 令我回不了家

我於2011年受到一位黑人 男友的欺騙,到馬來西亞 旅遊,經香港回國時,被 發現行李內藏有毒品,被 香港海關拘捕。經過一連 串盤問後,我被帶到大欖



懲教所,認識了很多內地的姊妹,她們跟我的案件類似,有著相同的遭遇。

我在香港經歷了五次審訊,被羈留超過五年。這期間我相信了耶穌,神給了我相當大的力量,在那些獨自面對悲痛、消沉及憤怒(對黑人,對自己)的日子,我每次都會讀經、 禱告,耶穌帶給我安慰、平安,更讓我知道:神必伸冤, 我告訴自己必須堅持到底。

上帝奇蹟地安排了一位很好的律師及團隊,首先令老闆遠從廣州來港作證,再替我找了電腦法證專家,成功還原500多張(有關黑人的)相片、錄音及錄影,令案件有新的證據,讓不可能的事變為可能。(續:後頁)



General Secretary Message "May those who delight in my vindication shout for joy and gladness; may they always say, "The LORD be exalted, who delights in the well-being of his servant." (Psalm 35:27)

In this issue, we are going to share the testimonies of two rehabilitated sisters. The two mainland ladies, were set up and found with drugs inside their luggage without any of their knowledge. They were given a sentence that was over 10 years. Luckily, they were all aquitted after a series of investigations. The process of their



serious drug offence appeals have tormented all of them for 5-6 years, before they could finally released. We could not help but thank God for His mercy on them. Both of them experienced God during their imprisonment.

Actually, some of our colleague were also rehabilitated from drug cases, one is "Shan". Although the background of their offences varied, Shan got in touch with drugs when she was very young. Eventually, she was sent to prison for 4.5 years. After release, Shan joined Kun Sun's vocational training programme and then served with us for 10 years. Since then, she could get back her normal life, enjoy freedom and start her church life. Most importantly, she could start learning how to nurture her son in God's way as a single mother. With a few life coaches to walk along with her, her church live is now stable and happy. She even always joins us to share her testimony in different institutions and churches.

I feel thankful to see our fellow colleagues who are all so willing to care and help when they see there are needs from these sisters. They lifted up their prayers to God through the love and hope in the gospel. The words and promises in the bible have helped them sail through the toughest time in their lives.

In the past 10 years, the multinational drug trafficking syndicates have been using different evil tactics to lure people like teenagers who are innocent and kind-to-help people, and/or the poor to be their traffickers, whom all end up behind bars, losing 10 years or more of their freedom. Having said that, there were surely also those some who dared to risk earning "quick money". All these contributed to a tremendous increase in drug offences. One of my pastor couple friends told me lately that their son, who is studying aboard and working part-time in a delivery company, has fallen into the trap of the drug dealers in his negligence. He was hence convicted and put in prison.

According to the HK police information from their website, a total of 2,800 cases of serious drug offence in average per year were recorded from 2007-09, while there were only 2,000 cases in average per year for 2010-16. Is this implying that people are more ignorant of the tactics of the drug dealers hence are more easily cheated than in the past? Later on, the figures dropped, but it still has to be confirmed whether this drop is a result of the public education.



In late February, our staff had a 2-day retreat in the Methodist Retreat Centre in Lantau Island. By meditating in the "Labyrinth", we were able to quietly reflection on our relationship with our God, with others, within ourselves, as well as to explore our ministry direction in the future. I personally benefited a lot. Staff have also deepened their understanding of each other. Everyone had so much fun from the group games, trying so hard to "argue" for their own advantage in the rules, which is exactly like the criminals who try to exploit the loopholes in the law. It fully revealed the dark side of our human nature, which will only bring failure in the end.



On March 28, we invited the brothers and sisters from churches, who have

participated in the Easter services in different prisons, to join our prayer meeting at Kun Sun. Representatives from different churches got the chance to know more about each other. They prayed with and for each other through the prayer meeting. We thank God for allowing all the outreaches to be held successfully and see harvest in over 30 prisons.

Be Aware of the "Vacation Trap"

In the past 7-8 years, there were more than 30 Chinese ladies arrested in Hong Kong for possession of dangerous drugs. As the amount of drugs carried were of a large amount, with a value of up to 1-2 million dollars, the cases were brought to the High Court. If convicted, they would be imprisoned for 10-30 years.

From the information provided by ladies who have been caught in this scenario, they were told by their employer or boyfriend (mainly foreign males) to bring a luggage of clothing samples, books, electrical appliances or other personal belongings from other countries to China.

These men find their target, single Chinese women, on the internet or they directly approach the female sales, merchandisers or shop owners in shopping centers. They claim that they own a garment trading business or retail shop, so they need to travel around frequently and collect samples from other nations.

The men usually make friends with the ladies first. And some of them even make an effort to become lovers of the ladies and lie that they want to marry. After they gain the friendship and trust from the ladies, they will lie that they need to travel to Malaysia, Indonesia, Thailand, Africa, Vietnam, etc. to collect samples and invite the ladies to go with them together. After they arrive at the destination, these men will claim they have a business meeting or another appointment, they send the ladies to pick up product samples and ask the ladies to bring

their luggage back to China first. When they transited in Hong Kong, they were arrested as drugs were found in the hidden compartments of their luggage.

Fortunately, some ladies incarcerated as a result of these cases attend bible class in the correctional institution. They believe in GOD and experienced God's grace for real.

Until now, none of the foreign men have been caught and prosecuted about these cases. They may continue to find vulnerable targets in Guangzhou or other places in China. So BE AWARE!

A long "journey"

In 2011, when I was returning back to China after my vacation in Malaysia, I was arrested at Hong Kong Airport and convicted of drug trafficking. Police told me that my luggage was found to have drugs inside.



That luggage was given by a friend of my boyfriend in Malaysia, I really had no idea about the drugs. I was so puzzled but after I arrived in Tai Lam Correctional Institution, I met so many sisters who had similar cases, I knew I was cheated.

My case was put to court five times. These five years were so long for me. Thankfully, I knew God during this period. God give me the strength to face the sadness, hopelessness and anger. I kept reading the bible and praying all the time, God's word comforted me and made me feel peace. I have the strength to keep on going as God said "Vengeance is mine".

It was such a miracle to meet a good lawyer and his team. They put in so much effort to find evidence for my case, especially recovering the 500 photos of my boyfriend through a Computer Forensic Specialist. This increased my chance to be released. (continued on next page)

Comment from Judging panel:

The cross formed by the clouds in the sky was a breath-taking scene. The man on the foreground of the photograph looked like he was hiking up the mountains ahead towards the cross. It is difficult to express the idea of being healed in a photograph. However, hiking is a great outdoor exercise and can help the body and mind to stay healthy which is also an aspect of being healed.

Thank you to my family members especially mother's church that kept praying for me! Also thanks to the pastors and the volunteers who always came to visit me, teach me God's word, and help me to overcome!

Am I dreaming?

I never thought that I would end up in prison, but things happened so suddenly, I was arrested for possession of dangerous drugs. It was just like a dream, but I knew it was happening. I was in Lo Wu Correctional Institution for 19 months.

At the most helpless time of my life, God came into my life. A day after my second month in Lo Wu, a madam invited me to join the bible class. This started a new page of my life.

God know all my needs, he sent his angels to me. Rev. Mya and brothers and sisters from church came to bible class and listened to my hopelessness of no freedom and the challenges of life changes. They teach me how to pray, so I keep praying when I couldn't sleep. I shared all my worries and sadness with God. God comforted my fears and ended my tears. God also sent me a wonderful lawyer to give so much assistant.

Thankful for God's grace and blessing, I was released. Although I experienced God's grace in the prison, I don't want others to have to go through the same thing of getting tricked and ending up in prison. I received many support and help from different people in my case. I never know if others will have such chances as I did, so I keep telling people about my past and warning



them not to be cheated. Also, the most important thing, let them know God is real.

Jesus is my Savior, God give me a new life so I promise to follow him forever. Amen.
